

Church Announcement for Memorial that Was Used for the Pilot Event:

In this year of mercy, we are encouraged to practice both spiritual and corporeal works of mercy, an example of which is burying the dead. Of course, before a burial there is a funeral. And yet, there are a group of our fellow human beings who, when they die, are unjustly deprived of a funeral and a burial, and that is aborted children.

That is why, on Friday, June 10 at St. Patrick's at 7:30pm, we are holding a memorial service for aborted children, as a way of showing honor and respect to these lost lives.

A secondary purpose of this event is to also provide an opportunity for healing and closure for all of us who have been affected by abortion.
